I read with interest the letter within a letter from Barbara Evans on page
7 consecutive page 777 in The Childress Chatter issue number 66, October 1995.
While I cannot answer the question of Mosby's parentage, I do believe I can shed some light on question number two concerning Susannah Goolsby.

You have my permission to print or not to print all or only part of the following data:

Who married Susannah Goolsby? The case for Henry Childers: Henry Childers bought land in Albermarle County 10 September 1755. (Bear in mind that Thomas Goolsby, Susannah's father was a resident of Albermarle County at this time.)

Source: Virginia Land Patent Book 31, 20 September 1751 to 10 September 1755, Part II. This was printed in Magazine Of Virginia Genealogy, Volume 31 Number 3, August 1993.

Henry and Susannah's names were listed on deeds dated 7 October 1765 and 27 August 1770, and on the latter John Goolsby signed as witness.

Source: The Deeds Of Amherst County, Virginia 1761 - 1807 And Albermarle County, Virginia 1748 - 1763 by Rev. Bailey Fulton Davis.

On a deed dated 1 December 1777, Henry Childers received land from William Goolsby, executor of Thomas Goolsby, deceased, and the deed states that the land was patented by William's father, Thomas Goolsby, at Williamsburg 16 February 1771.

Henry Childers is the probable father of Goolsberry/Goolsby Childers, the Rev. War veteran. Moses Swinney, Henry Childers and Goolsberry Childers owned adjoining lands atop the Blue Ridge in Amherst County, and then Henry and Goolsberry are found in the part of Kentucky now called Garrard County in the 1790's and early 1800's. Goolsberry had a son Henry and daughter Susannah. Source: various deeds and tax records of Amherst County, Virginia and Lincoln, and Garrard Counties, Kentucky. DAR record of Goolsberry Childers.

The name Goolsby was used by Henry and Susannah's son, Robert, for his son Goolsby and by Robert's son Henry for his son, Henry Goolsby. Think practical and you know no one but a Goolsby descendant would use that name for a child!

Let us not assume that there was only one Susannah Goolsby or only one Childers who married a Goolsby. The first Goolsby land patent known is dated 1732, leaving many years for one or more Goolsbys to have grown up and married a Childers.

p.s. If anyone can prove me right or wrong, please send me your PROOF. I will read and consider.
