#### The Oldest Citizen of Rolla Gone From Among Us.

All that was mortal of John Weber was laid in the dust on Saturday last in the family lot in the Rolla cemetery. The funeral was conducted by the Masonic lodges of Edgar Springs and Rolla. A deputation of the former accompanied the body from the Weber homestead on Corn Creek to Rolla, where they were met by the brethren of the Rolla lodge at the Masonic Hall on Pine Street, from whence they marched to the cemetery. At the grave the Rev. J. J. Watts performed the usual Christian services. In his humble, plain and simple way the Christian minister told the story of the latter end of the life of a good man, of his faith in God, his belief in the immortality of the soul, and that his last words on earth were "that he was prepared to meet his God." The words of the faithful preacher deeply affected the friends and old companions of the departed, for they knew they were not a travesty on truth, as is too common on such occasions, but the truth itself. Rolla Lodge No. 213 A. F. & A. M., of which the deceased was one of its oldest members, now performed the last sad rites in the impressive forms as laid down in the Masonic ritual. The sprig of evergreen and the white apron were silently dropped in the uncovered grave, followed by the timehonored 'Farewell, Farewell." The grand honors were then given accompanied with the ancient landmark of "The will of God is accomplished. So mote it Amen."

The death of John Weber removes a landmark from among us. He was the oldest citizen of our town, and one of its best. He was a man that made no enemies. No one was ever heard to say aught against him. He was a good neighbor, a good friend, and a good enemy. If it is true what the poet says that "An honest man is the noblest work of God," John Weber was one of God's noblemen.

He leaves, as is well known, a large number of relatives, and of personal friends to mourn his loss, a loss which never can be supplied. His bereaved widow and fatherless children have the sympathy of the entire community in their affliction. And may the blessing which is promised by the God of the fatherless and of the widow be theirs.

Mrs. Lucinda Weber died at the home of her son, Frank Weber, near Edgar Springs, in Spring Creek township, Wednesday morning, November 3, 1909, in the 74th year of her age

Mrs. Weber was formerly Miss Lucinda Sally, of this county. She was united in marriage with John Weber, the original pioneer settler of Rolla. The wedding took place during the war, and was a grand affair during that time. For a number of years Mr. and Mrs. Weber resided in Rolla, but afterwards moved to his farm near Edgar Springs. Of the union seven children were born, four of whom survive: Edward, who resides in the state of Washington; A. J. Weber, of St. Louis: Mrs. James Dunham and Frank Weber, of Edgar Springs. In addition there are two step-children: Mrs. A. J. Weber, of Galatia, Illinois, and A. N. Weber, who resides in Arkansas. John Weber, her husband, preceded her to the grave in 1889. A large circle of friends and relatives mourn her loss.

She was a devout christian character, and loved by all who knew her.


Her funeral will be held to-day at 2 o'clock, and interment will take place at the Smith cemetery, three and a half miles southwest of Edgar Springs.


