Los Angeles Ast Cimes COUNTY CORONE **BUSY OFFICIAL** Twelve Violent Deaths in Kern Since First of Month Sixteen Victims of Auto Smashes This Year Two Women Meet Weath in Fire at Waller's Basin BAKERSFIELD, March 22,-Kern county's twelfth victim of violent death since the first of March was recorded last night by Coroner Norman C. Houre when Mrs. Julia Mary Blakely, \$5 years of age, of Los An-geles, died at a local hospital as the result of injuries received in a terrific automobile crash south of here last Saturday evening. Records at the Coroner's office show that Mrs. Blakely was the sixteenth auto-crash victim to die and the fifth during this month, here since the first of the year, which to date has shown an average of more than one violent death, either by murder, suicide or accident, every two days.

Mrs. Blakely is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Webber, who is in a local hospital, as a result of the auto crash which claimed the life of her mother, and another daughter who resides in Taft. A double inquest into the deaths of Mrs. Ellen Green, 67, and her daughter, 45, both of New Jersey, both of whom were burned to death last Monday night in a fire at Walker's Basin, was conducted late today by Monday hight in a fire at Walker's Basin, was conducted late today by Coroner House.
